### Tar and Tarry - answers

1. **True** - 13000 deaths from tobacco use were reported in 2005, compared to 356 for illegal drug use - no reported deaths ever from cannabis use.
2. **This is true** - By age 11 1/3 of children will have tried smoking and by the age of 16 2/3 will have experimented.
3. **False**-Young women smoke, and drink more than their counterparts, although they are less likely to take illegal drugs. - *Use as discussion point - why do young women smoke more than young men - desire to look more mature, weight. Young men more likely to progress to smoking tobacco as a result of smoking cannabis*
4. **2 million** - Uk figures
5. **False** - tobacco is an addictive substance no matter how it is smoked.
6. **True** - 28% of young people have used cannabis- under 20's - 21.3%- 20-24 year olds 13.2% 24 years plus 14.3% use cannabis. 8% of young people use drugs regularly (a few times a year to most days)  
(Drug misuse statistics Scotland) Stats mostly come from those who have contact with criminal justice system.
7. **1 month** -*which means drug tests may not be accurate. Could stay in system longer. Passive smoking can also mean that it stays in the system for a long time.*
8. **1994** - *(nicotine is a mild stimulant, only found in tobacco plant) discussion point, why did they not admit addictive before then?*

15. *1000 +. Tobacco smoke contains 4000 chemical compounds for example, arsenic, cyanide, formaldehyde, carbon monoxide, and nicotine. Cigarettes are high quality, nicotine delivery systems.*

17. *True -Cannabis burns at high temperature and produces carcinogens combined with tobacco increases carcinogens. no filter, breathe in longer and inhale deeper (query filters).*
18. *True the levels are stronger - but probably not as high as opponents of cannabis use say. This is due to hydroponics and home growing skunk and stronger strains. People tend to smoke less of stronger stuff.  
It is grass and skunk that can be stronger - people have more access to different kinds. Resin probably much the same as in the past.*
19. *False - cannabis can be one factor in many, leading to schizophrenic type illnesses if person smokes heavily from a young age and is predisposed to the illness. Studies that have taken place were with very small numbers. People with mental illness often use cannabis to self-medicate.(Arsenault et al (2004); Semple et al (2005); Henguet et al (2005); Van Os et al (2002); Zammit et al (2002); MacLeod et al (2004))*
20. *Paranoia, short-term memory loss, increased appetite, nausea, anxiety, malaise/manyana syndrome, hearing and seeing things that aren't there. Heart racing. Loss of inhibition; giggles, munchies, relaxing, stress relief, pain relief/muscle relaxant, increases appreciation of music and colour, loss of inhibition; creativity.*
21. *True - when eaten cannabis is metabolised by the liver and has a stronger effect on the body. Smaller amounts will have a stronger impact.*

*Skunk has higher THC levels which has more hallucinogenic properties. Other types of grass i.e. Northern lights the other cannabinoids are more predominant and have a different effect. Soap bar has a more heavy effect - will make users more sleepy -this is most commonly used by young people.*
